RISK MANAGEMENT POLICY

Cronulla RSL Youth Soccer Club aims to use best practice in risk management to support and enhance our activities in all areas of our club. We will ensure risk management is an integral part of all our decision-making processes. We will identify and take advantage of opportunities as well as minimizing adverse effects. We will facilitate training for our people to implement risk management effectively. We will strive to continually improve our risk management practices.

RESPONSIBILITIES

The Risk Management Sub-Committee appointed by the Executive is accountable to the Executive for the implementation of the risk management process and ultimately responsible for the management of risks in the club. All key personnel are responsible for managing risks in their areas.

PROCESS CONSTITUTED

A risk management procedure has been established, based on the requirements of the NSW State body and Australian Standard AS/NZS ISO 31000:2009 and the National Risk Management Guidelines. It should be used for guidance by everyone involved with the application of risk management.

MONITORING AND REVIEW

The Risk Management Sub-Committee will monitor and review the implementation of the risk management program and report to the Executive at regular intervals (not less than every 2 months).

The Risk Management Sub-committee will facilitate the development of a common risk management approach across areas of our club by:

- implementing the risk management program
- sharing information with broad applicability across all areas
- reporting on the progress of implementing the risk management program.
